Category: TMAC Volunteer of the Year

Type: Recognition Award

Description: This award is presented to an outstanding TMAC member, in good standing, who has demonstrated an instrumental role as a volunteer. The recipient exemplifies dedication, leadership, and commitment to service, contributing meaningfully to the association's initiatives, programs, or events.

Judging Considerations: Use the criteria below to help guide your evaluation and decision. You will choose one winner and two honourable mentions. Judges should assign a score for each criterion (e.g., 0–5 or 0–10 points per category, with no half-points). The total possible score is 35 points. The entry with the highest cumulative score will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the final decision will be determined through discussion among the judges during the final deliberation meeting.

Leadership & Initiative Demonstrates vision, motivation, and the ability to inspire others while taking on volunteer roles or leading projects that benefit TMAC and its members.	10
Significant Impact The volunteer's contributions resulted in tangible benefits to the association, such as enhanced programs, successful events, improved member engagement, or increased organizational visibility.	10
Professional Excellence Reflects consistent reliability, attention to detail, and a high level of professionalism in fulfilling volunteer responsibilities and collaborating with TMAC staff and members.	10
Overall excellence Exemplifies outstanding commitment and dedication to TMAC through sustained volunteer efforts, going above and beyond expectations.	5
